  - 1. <u>Call to Order</u>: The President, Bill Stafford, called the meeting to order at 8:33 AM.

  - 5.   - 6. A motion was made by Rhona Beadle, seconded by Mandy Chew and unanimously approved <u>to reconsider the motion made by this Board on November 9 to acquire the bronze heron statue.</u>
  - 7. A motion was made by Bill Stafford, seconded by Dan Cashman and unanimously approved to <u>table the motion to acquire the bronze heron statue</u>.
  - 8. Discussion ensued regarding the formation of an ad hoc committee to develop ideas. Upon a motion made by Dan Cashman, seconded by Linda Dodge and unanimously approved <u>it was resolved to form an ad hoc committee of GPOA members with a</u> <u>liaison to the GPOA Board, whose purpose is to develop three ideas for the Front</u>

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Entrance and bring to the Board along with costs and renderings for Board review by the end of January 2019; and thereafter be made available to general membership for input. Rhona Beadle offered to be liaison and was approved.

9. <u>Adjournment</u>: There being no further business to discuss, upon a motion made, seconded and carried, the meeting was adjourned.
